



## General Pool information

You have registered your child to attend this weeks' pool trip/ trips. Your child will be transported via KIDS CO-OP bus or bus service to Nazareth Borough Pool unless otherwise informed. Pool trips are normally 11:30 am to 3:30 pm on the designated pool day.

\* The pool is located on North Broad Street in Nazareth, just less than 5 miles from the gym. The Nazareth pool ranges from a 0-foot entrance to a 12-foot deep end. All campers will remain in the 0-3-foot section until a swim test is conducted. Campers who are new to swimming, or are not strong swimmers, it is recommended they wear a Coast Guard Certified life jacket (must have strap between legs - no arm floaties).

\*For the safety of all campers, swim tests are administered and regulated by the pool staff on a **pre-determined schedule**. The schedule is posted at the sign in desk. Please sign up your child if you would like them to take a swim test at one of these times.

\* Campers must wear shoes or sandals from the time we leave the gym to arrival at the pool and again on the return trip from the pool to the gym. **No bare feet at any time outside of the pool area. All campers must bring their own sunscreen and wear it daily.** KIDS CO-OP staff will help to apply sunscreen with the cooperation of campers.

\* If your child likes to swim with goggles, that is fine if they bring them, but there cannot be a nose piece attached. Please make sure their name is on towels, goggles, shoes/sandals, sunscreen. Please send a plastic bag for campers to use for wet clothes. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items; however, we will make every effort to help locate a lost item.

\* Staffing for pool trips and camp are based on registrations. We cannot accommodate requests to cancel once a child is registered. If your child changes their mind about attending a pool trip you will need to arrange to have your child picked up by 12:30 pm. There are no refunds for cancellations.

### **KIDS CO-OP Code of Conduct Policy –**

**For the safety of all children, we must be able to address unacceptable, unsafe, inappropriate, or disrespectful behavior.** Children are not permitted to run off from the group, participate in unsafe behavior, scream, hit themselves or others, or be disrespectful to coaches and/or other campers. Since every child and coach is a representative of KIDS CO-OP when offsite, inappropriate behavior will impact the child's opportunity to attend offsite pool and field trips, and parents will be notified accordingly.
